

Registration in Manage2Sail

Registration for HTR takes place in the Manage2Sail system maintained by SPV. The registration will open as soon as the transfer to the new system has been completed. In the M2S system, you will find all instructions and results regarding the competition throughout the competition process.

Your own profile is created in the M2S system. The profile is boat specific and the information is user managed. When you register for your first race through Manage2Sail, create an account for yourself (Create Account button). This needs to be done once. After that, you will use the same profile every time you register for a competition in any club that uses Manage2Sail. If you want to change or continue your previous registration, you can log in at portal.manage2sail.com and select a contest for your upcoming events. Registration can be changed for the skipper meeting on 13.8. until.

The profile must be filled in with all the information required to register for the competition. The system requires you to verify your email address by clicking on the link in the message sent to the email address you provided. If you already have a profile, log in using the email address and password you previously provided. If any of the required information is missing from your profile, you must complete it before you can proceed.

The competition entry fee will be handled by bank transfer. You will receive bank details when you register. Be sure to enter HTR2020 in the message field.

The boat information must include the boat's sail number with country code, name, club (may be different from skipper's club) and country. The draft field must be filled in with the boat's draft, width, waterline length and other necessary additional information for port arrangements.

Each registrant must enter their FinRating equalization number into the system. The competition uses the FinRating system maintained by offshore sailors. If your boat is so-called. table boat, the chapter can be found on the Offshore Sailors website:

<http://avomeripurjehtijat.org/taoituspurjehdus>. In Manage2Sail, the FinRating number is entered in TCF (time correction factor). In the case of ORC smoothing, the data is automatically retrieved from the international database based on the sail number. In both cases, also enter the type of boat.

The Race Marina is intended for all boats participating in the race. The berth is booked directly from Helsinki Marina. The nightly rate between Thursday and Friday is included in the registration

Skipper's Briefing

The Skipper's Briefing will be held on Thursday August 13th 2020 at 6.30 pm in Helsinki Marina, Katajanokka.

Boat representation at the Skipper's Briefing is mandatory. The skipper of the boat may authorize another person to represent the boat. The Skipper's Briefing will distribute monitoring equipment and competition material.

The boat's crew list must be stored in the registration system prior to the Skipper's Briefing

At the Skipper's Briefing, a guarantee signed by the skipper on the boat's compliance with the requirements must be handed over.

Boat and crew documents

The boat must have the permits and documents required by the authorities for the boat and its equipment and crew. At a minimum, these are:

the ship 's radio license, and

- Coastal Shipper's Radio Certificate for one crew member (SRC certificate)

Boats in accordance with section 2.4 a) of the invitation to tender must have a certificate of valid SPV inspection.

All crew members must have the required travel documents (valid passports, official EU identity cards) for traffic between Finland and Estonia.

Competitors are advised to use a courtesy ticket.

Haven Kakumäe

All boats staying in Kakumäe will be assigned a place on behalf of the race organizers. The distribution of berths will be based on the registration situation and will be published on the HTR website during the race week. For the marina, we need information about boats. Please note that the boat's skipper is responsible for securing the boat to the marina. The information must be completed when registering on the form.
